
Cancer Burden in Pakistan Fact Sheet

- Every year 340000 people develop cancer in Pakistan
- ▶ Only 71600 patients get adequate treatment and majority of cancer patients remain untreated.
- ▶ Around 367 Cancer Patients die daily without getting proper treatment.
- One Cancer Patient dies every4 minuets, un-helped & un-treated.

Palliative Care

Palliative Care is specialized medical care for people with cancer. It focuses on providing relief from distressing and agonizing symptoms of cancer. The goal is to improve quality of life of both the patient and his family. Cancer Care Hospital & Research Centre is the 1st in Pakistan to provide a special team of doctors, nurses, social workers and other specialists who will work together to provide palliative care services to patients. Radiation therapy

Radiation therapy is one of the most important treatments of cancer. High-energy radiations are used to shrink tumor and kill cancer cells. Majority of cancer patients need some type of radiation therapy during the course of their illness. Presently because of shortage of radiation machines patients have to wait for 5 to 8 months for radiation tratment and during this period many patients die and in others disease progresses. Cancer Care Hospital & Research Centre is starting construction of Radiation Block soon. It will provide free of cost radiation therapy to all patients. For this purpose we immediately require 5 radiation machines. Each machine costs Rs. 100 million. Please donate or contribute generously.

Prof. Dr. Shaharyar receives "National Human Rights Award "2016"



"Health is a Human Right"

Prof. Dr. Shaharyar has received National Human Rights Award 2016, from Ministry of Human Rights, Government of Pakistan in recognition of his services in the field of Cancer. President of Pakistan, Mamnoon Hussain conferred this award during a ceremony held in Awan-e-sadar Islamabad on 10th of December 2016.

Prof. Dr. Shaharyar is the founder of Cancer Care Hospital, a largest charitable 400 bedded hospital, spread over an area of 23 acres which is under construction on Raiwind Road Lahore, where treatment of cancer will be free of cost and no patient will be refused. Prof. Dr. Shaharyar strongly advocates that the provision of health care services should be considered a fundamental human right and these should be provided free of cost to every citizen without any discrimination.

Prof. Dr. Shaharyar is a well-known figure in the oncology community of Pakistan. He is known for his dedication and commitment to cancer patients and cancer research. He is a popular teacher of Oncology and Radiobiology and has a teaching experience of 30 years. As a physician he has treated more than 100,000 cancer patients in the last 30 years of his career. He has been honored with various awards and gold medals for his services and cancer research in oncology including lifetime Achievement Award by Pakistan Society of Clinical Oncology, Distinguished Services Award for Cancer Research and Shams uz Zaman Memorial Gold Medal. He is also a Co- recipient of Kobayashi Foundation Award 2010, from Japan. He has also contributed in the development of new Anti-cancer Drugs and has developed new treatment options for breast and ovarian cancer. He has helped many institutions in the development of Hospital Based Tumor Registries for the record keeping of cancer patients and establishment of Ethical Review Boards for the standardization of biomedical research. He regularly conducts Medical Writing Workshops for synopses, dissertations, theses and Protocol Writing.

Cancer Care Hospital has started **Free Mammography Service** for early detection of breast cancer in Pakistan. Three state of the art digital machines have been imported from Italy each for Rs. 20 Million. One machine has been installed at Hijaz Hospital, Gulberg, Lahore and the other two Machines are Mobile Floats which are designed to deliver services at the door step to the general public. Each mobile vehicle is operated by two Medical Imaging Technologists. A Central Hub at Al Razi Medical Centre sends immediate reports where Dr. Muhammad Fiaz, a Senior Radiologist is providing free reporting of Mammography, Ultrasound and Biopsy Service.




